Art - Ancient Egyptian Scrolls

This unit focuses on exploring and creating Ancient Egyptian art, guiding pupils in understanding and applying the styles, patterns, and techniques of Ancient Egyptian art through lessons that include designing scrolls, making paper, and creating contemporary responses using zines.

Ancient	In historical terms it is something from a long time ago and no longer exists
Colour	A feature of everything in the world that is seen through the way it reflects light
Composition	Putting different elements together in a pleasing way
Egyptian	Someone or something descendant from Egypt
Imagery	A collection of images from a range of art forms
Layout	The arrangement of different elements within a given space
Papyrus	A riverside plant used to make paper
Pattern	Pattern is a design in which shapes, colours or lines are repeated
Technique	Skills applied by an artist to produce a particular art form



Key Knowledge and Skills:

- Confidently use a range of materials and tools, selecting and using these appropriately with more independence.
- Use hands and tools confidently to cut, shape and join materials for a purpose.
- Know pattern can be man-made (like a printed wallpaper) or natural (like a giraffe's skin).
- Know that layering materials in opposite directions makes the handmade paper stronger.
- Use a sketchbook to research a subject using different techniques and materials to present ideas.
- How to construct a new paper material using paper, water and glue
